

Terms & Conditions



The Organizers have the right to change or modify the floor plan to accommodate other exhibitors. The Organizers have the right to use any pictures, images, ads or articles taken during or after the event in any promotional brochures, advertisements, commercials, website, or any other form of marketing now or in the future.

The Exhibitor agrees not to dismantle or vacate their booth before the official end of the event, unless authorized in writing by the Organizers.

The Exhibitor agrees to pay the full amount due before the space is reserved.

Any request for additional equipment and accessories at the event are extra and not included in the event cost. Arrangements can be made through the Keystone.

The Organizers may make rules at its sole discretion for the orderly operation and appearance of the event.

The Organizers reserve the right to reject or prohibit Exhibits, or Exhibitors whom management considers do not meet the goals of the Career Symposium.

The Exhibitor shall not conduct him/herself, or operate any equipment at a level of sound, that is determined at the sole discretion of management to be detrimental to the welfare of the show or other Exhibitors.

Reasonable security shall be provided at all times on the show premises, primarily to ensure public safety. Exhibitor's property shall be placed on display at its own risk and the Organizers assume no liability for loss or damage thereto. The Exhibitor shall assume all responsibility for loss or damage to his/her property due to theft, fire, flood or any other cause beyond the control of the Organizers. Exhibits must comply with fire regulations. All display materials must be fireproof.

In case of cancellation, sixty (60) days' notice must be given to the Organizers in advance, before the first day of the event for full refunds. The Exhibitor agrees to pay the Organizers fifty (50) percent of the amount agreed on if notice is less than sixty (60) days, but more than thirty (30) days prior to the event. No refund will be given on cancellations made one month or less prior to the first day of the symposium. The Exhibitor must inform the Organizers on any cancellation in writing by letter, fax, or email.
