

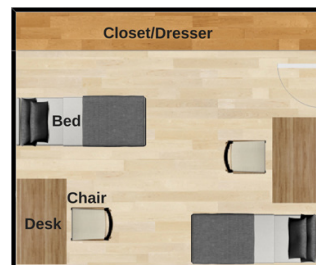
**4** co-ed residence halls & 2 apartment buildings

**Cook Hall – \$1,350 per semester\***

Located near the Student Center, Cook Hall is the largest residence hall on campus. This hall is co-ed by floor and provides a lively atmosphere for students. Amenities include a large study room, full kitchen, community-style bathrooms, microwave access and laundry facilities on every floor, an elevator, a central recreational lounge, and internet. Rooms are furnished with beds, desks, chairs, closets, and dressers.



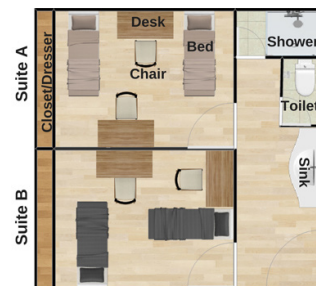
**Crane Hall – \$1,641 per semester\***

More centralized to academic buildings, Crane Hall is a co-ed, suite-style residence hall where two rooms share a bathroom facility. This hall provides a comfortable living environment while encouraging community and diversity among students. Amenities include a full kitchen, laundry facilities, and recreational lounges on every floor, an elevator, internet, and air conditioning. Rooms are carpeted and furnished with beds, desks, chairs, closets, and dressers.



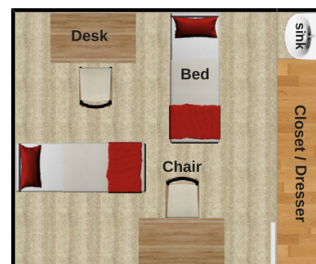
**Lura Manor – \$1,641 per semester\***

Lura Manor is a co-ed and gender inclusive suite-style residence hall where two rooms share a bathroom facility. This hall offers students community, diversity, and a comfortable living environment. Amenities include study nooks, recreational lounges, and microwave access on every floor, kitchenettes, an elevator, internet, air conditioning, and three laundry facilities throughout the building. Rooms are furnished with beds, desks, chairs, closets, and dressers.



**McCulloch Hall – \$1,350 per semester\***

McCulloch Hall is co-ed by floor, and located near the Student Center. Amenities include laundry facilities, community-style bathrooms, microwave access on every floor, two recreational lounges, a kitchenette, and internet. Rooms are carpeted and furnished with beds, desks, chairs, closets, and dressers.
