Federal Financial Aid

Students are encouraged to apply for Federal Financial Aid, which includes:

FEDERAL and STATE GRANTS

Financial aid that typically doesn't have to be repaid (unless, for example, you withdraw from school and owe a refund.)

LOANS

Borrowed money that you must repay, with interest. In most cases, repayment will begin six months after you drop below half time status (six credit hours) or complete your program.

WORK STUDY

A work program in which you earn money through campus employment to help you pay for school and cover personal expenses throughout the year.

International and Canadian students do not qualify for federal student aid programs. Canadian loans are accepted.

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

Minot State FAFSA priority funding deadline: **April 15**
School Code: **002994**

The FAFSA will be available on **October 1**. Submit your FAFSA as soon as possible to avoid delays. Be sure to submit a FAFSA every year.

By submitting the FAFSA, you maximize your eligibility for student aid programs, including:

- Federal SEOG Grant
 - Federal Work Study
 - Federal Pell Grant
 - Federal TEACH Grant
 - Federal Direct Loan programs
 - ND State Grant (*ND high school graduates should apply ASAP after October 1 for consideration*)
- Apply by priority deadline of April 15 for consideration.*

Transfer Student Scholar Award
